

SNOWBOARD PROGRAMS

Competition Team. 3, and 2 day. (Ages 10-19)

The Competition Team will concentrate and compete in half pipe, slopestyle, slalom and giant slalom mainly in Northern Vermont's USASA Series. A typical day for this group includes drills in the halfpipe, big air technique training and slopestyle runs through the park. . If you're not afraid of challenges and you like riding, then this is where you belong.

FreeRide Team. 1 day. (Ages 8-18)

The focus of this program is to push each athlete to improve his or her overall riding ability. Encouraging riders to explore the entire mountain, including groomed runs, glades, steep terrain, terrain parks and the halfpipe. It's a positive learning environment from which the athletes can extend their personal boundaries. Riders will be divided in to age/ability appropriate groups to insure that each athlete receives coaching that matches his/her skills. Competitions are available for halfpipe, slopestyle, slalom and giant slalom through the USASA Northern Vermont Series. (Membership in the USASA is required to enter these competitions)

Ride Meister Team: 1 day. (Ages 6-10)

The Ride Meister Team offers junior riders a fun and educational snowboarding atmosphere. Ride Meisters are able to ride top to bottom on intermediate terrain. The main focus of the team is to advance the overall riding skill level. They will ride the entire mountain and begin to explore beginner tree runs, mid-sized jumps and entry-level half-pipe riding.

- Competitions are available to interested athletes from any program.
- Recommended age groups are guidelines only.
- An **early season assessment** of skier/ rider ability will ensure proper placement.
